## APAH's Gilliam Place Named 2020 Best Affordable Housing Development



Arlington, VA (November 20, 2020) – On Thursday, Gilliam Place, APAH's newest property, was recognized with a Virginia Housing Award for Best Affordable Housing Development at the Virginia Governor's Housing Conference.

"Arlington County has lost much of its affordable housing," said Carmen Romero, APAH's Vice President

of Real Estate Development. "The genesis of this project was to create opportunities for 173 low-income households to live in this high-opportunity area."

Recognized for its innovation and effective design, Gilliam Place is a mixed-use six-story development located in the heart of Columbia Pike Town Center. All the apartments are affordable to households earning 60% of the area median income (AMI) or below. The project includes nearly 9,000 square feet of commercial and civic space for the Church's new worshipping space and La Cocina VA, a bilingual culinary training center and onsite café that opened just this year.

"APAH is honored to be recognized for this collaboration with Arlington Presbyterian Church. We hope this project is a model for other faith institutions across the nation and a testament to the power of faith in service for their communities," said APAH President/CEO, Nina Janopaul. "The pandemic has been difficult for many APAH families, but Arlington Presbyterian Church continues to be a wonderful partner and neighbor to our community through their volunteer work and generosity."
